The Odell Brewing Company, family owned and operated, produces 28,000 barrels annually. Founder, Doug Odell, began peddling his 90 Shilling Ale out of his pickup truck in 1989. In addition to 90 Shilling, a full-bodied amber ale, Odell's other popular brews includes Easy Street Wheat, an unfiltered American-style wheat beer which was the Gold Medal Winner at the 2005 Great American Beer Festival. Cutthroat Porter, a robust creamy dark ale and 5 Barrel are both brewed in the English Tradition. Levity Golden Amber, Isolation Ale and Bobby, a German Kolsch-style ale that is light in color but full of flavor, are all available to sample at the brewery 6 days a week.
